



WVU Information Literacy Course Enhancement Grants Sponsored by the WVU Libraries and the Office of the Provost *Deadline: March 11, 2011*

What is information literacy? Broadly speaking, information literacy is the set of abilities needed for 21st century learning by students and instructors. It means making effective use of the dazzling array of information options in the university environment. It requires critical thinking in selection of sources for academic work. Since 2009, thanks to the WVU Libraries' Information Literacy Course Enhancement Grant Program (ILCEP), eleven faculty/librarian teams have taken action to address it as a high priority in their courses. There was a Showcase of 2010 project results from the first five teams during the Faculty Academy in May 2010. The University has now adopted a **2020 Strategic Plan** which calls for “engaging undergraduate, graduate, and professional students in a challenging academic environment.” To encourage the development of stronger students, better research, *and* a challenging academic environment at WVU during the 2011-2012 year, the ILCEP program offers summer stipends to bring librarians and faculty together for course enhancement.

WVU Libraries have taken leadership to promote an Information Literacy Initiative over the last four years and the ILCEP grant program is an important part of that effort. In cooperation with the office of the Provost, the next stage of development will be the selection of at least five more teams in 2011 to further demonstrate to our faculty and students the academic success that is possible by integrating information literacy into the curriculum in more disciplines. We encourage applications from faculty in all disciplines.

Objectives of the Grants

\$3000.00 summer grants (or other relevant professional remuneration if 12-month faculty members apply) will be given to instructors to enhance a course substantially by integrating information literacy instruction. Objectives include:

- To strengthen student research results and prepare them for greater academic success.
- To foster collaboration between instructors and librarians.
- To implement syllabus enhancement to include information literacy based learning outcomes and information literacy active learning assignments within the discipline.
- To encourage instructors to include the full range of the WVU Libraries' resources, expertise, and services in course planning and delivery in courses with research expectations.
- To sponsor an Information Literacy Showcase to share the results of the course enhancements, publicize discipline based projects, and encourage more departments to get involved.
